(1)	#X7076B	Sonata Level 2 Kit - (1) 4" x 4" small flower B&T
(1)	#Z283	Colonial White My Accents™ - (1) button
(1)	#Z2111	Chocolate Ink Pad
(1)	#Z726	Sponge Daubers
(1)	#1512	Bonding Memories Glue
(1)	#Z534	Micro-tip Scissors
(1)	#1684	Self-Healing Craft Mat
(1)	#Z533	Cutting Knife
(1)	#Z355	Bubblegum Waxy Flax



Additional Items/Instructions:

Sandpaper (optional)

Assembly Instructions:

- [1]** Dab adhesive on the top side of the dimensional element and adhere it to the backside of a B&T piece of your choice.
- [2]** Lay the element face down onto the Self-Healing Craft Mat. Using the cutting knife, carefully cut away the B&T paper around the element as close as possible.
- [3]** Open up the blades of the Micro-tip Scissors and use the blade to gently carve away the edges of the B&T paper and element for a "shabby chic" look.

*For a smoother look you can use a soft-grade sandpaper piece in place of the Micro-tip Scissors.
- [4]** Using chocolate ink and a sponge dauber, daub the edges of the element gently to give the element a more finished look that "pops".
- [5]** Add embellishments.
